

HOUSE RULES

Welcome to Festspielhaus Bregenz. To make your visit as pleasant as possible, we kindly ask all visitors to observe the following points.

ACCESS AND STAY

- _ Please behave in a way that does not endanger, harm, obstruct or disturb others.
- _ Persons who are visibly under the influence of alcohol, drugs or other intoxicating substances will be refused admission. They may also be asked to leave the premises if they behave inappropriately.
- _ Parents, legal guardians or persons appointed by them are responsible for supervising minors. The applicable youth protection regulations must be observed.
- _ Animals are not permitted on the premises. Guide and assistance dogs are exempt from this rule.

SAFETY

- _ Bringing or using objects or materials that may pose safety risk (e.g. pyrotechnic items or aerosol cans), as well as objects whose possession or use is subject to weapons legislation, is prohibited.
- _ Emergency escape routes must be kept clear and may only be used in an emergency.
- _ Bulky items such as coats, jackets, umbrellas or suitcases must be stored in the designated areas to keep passageways clear and ensure safe evacuation.

CONDUCT IN THE BUILDING

- _ Smoking is only permitted in the designated outdoor areas.
- _ Taking photographs, videos or audio recordings is only permitted with the prior permission of the event organiser, regardless of the equipment used.
- _ Any changes to the venue's fixtures and furnishings (e.g. furniture or decorations) may only be carried out by trained staff of Festspielhaus Bregenz.
- _ The distribution or sale of goods or printed materials within the building or on the premises is only permitted with the approval of Kongresskultur Bregenz GmbH.
- _ Actions or content that violate the constitutional order or are discriminatory, extremist or xenophobic are prohibited.
- _ The instructions of staff must be followed.

LIABILITY

- _ Violations of the House Rules may result in a ban from the premises. No entitlement to compensation shall arise.
