For you, the certification of a Green Meeting or Green Event at Festspielhaus Bregenz involves little effort, because ...

- Festspielhaus Bregenz is already certified as an event venue.
- Our catering partner eventTZ by foodaffairs already has the necessary certification as a Green Caterer.
- As a licence holder, the Festspielhaus team can certify your events.

This means that the majority of the criteria have already been met and only a few steps are necessary to obtain the certificate.

Which events can be certified?

There are few types of event that cannot be certified. As a certification body for Green Meetings & Green Events, we will be happy to provide you with detailed information.

What are the costs?

The advice we give on certification and the certification procedure is free of charge for you.



Seven steps to certification

Your contact person will be on hand to advise and help out.

How does the certification work?

The certification consists of MANDATORY and TARGET criteria. In order for your event to become a Green Meeting & Event, all MANDATORY criteria must be fulfilled.

In addition, a certain minimum number of points must be achieved through the fulfilment of TARGET criteria.



Profitable measures at a glance



Mobility and climate protection

- Encourage participants to use public transport or organise car sharing to reduce emissions.
- When selecting side events, make sure they are easy to reach.



Hosts with environmental awareness

- Inform your participants about eco-certified local hotels.
- Choose a Green Hotel as your team hotel.



Conserving resources in planning and décor

- Prefer digital communications and save costs on printed invitations and programme booklets.
- Reduce the use of writing utensils and giveaways.
- Save resources by reusing décor, name badges and various materials.
- Try to consistently disconnect appliances from the mains and use energy-efficient appliances.



Waste separation and avoidance

- Use the location's waste management system to easily separate waste.
- Opt for reusable materials and reduce plastic waste.



High-quality regional catering

- Help to avoid food waste with careful planning.
- Avoid the use of disposable tableware.
- Emphasise regional, seasonal food when choosing your menu.



Communication

- Show your principles and champion sustainable event organisation.
- Tell the participants about your sustainability drive and encourage them to get actively involved.
- At the end of the event, evaluate your sustainability goals and share your experiences and progress with others.



Social responsibility for participants and employees

- If you make an event barrier-free, you enable everyone to take part in it (people with disabilities, older people, families, etc.).
- In your communications, ensure that all genders are addressed.
- Pay attention to the safety and security of all participants.

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
